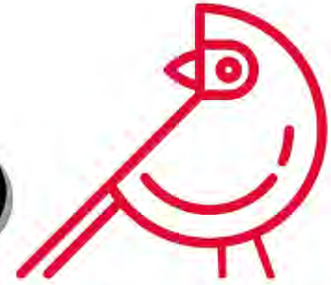

Curriculum Night

Curriculum night will take place on September 30 from 5-7:30 p.m. The schedule is below. Please start in your child's homeroom.

Curriculum night is a chance for parents to learn about classroom procedures, homework, schedules, and expectations. Teachers will also go over grading policies and most will create a PowerPoint presentation to share with all parents. This is not a time to meet one-on-one with your child's teacher. Fall conferences are best for this and will be scheduled soon. Curriculum night is a time just for parents (no students, please).

First Paid Dress Down Day—**New**



The first paid dress down day will take place on **Thursday, September 23**. Students may pay \$3.50 to wear their favorite college or NFL football team shirt or jersey with any uniform bottom. Spirit wear shirts are also acceptable, however you still must pay. Purchase tickets for the dress down [here](#). If you purchased a dress down pass with your school start pack, you do NOT need to purchase an additional ticket. All proceeds go to the athletics department.

Communication Devices

CCA policy prohibits students from bringing cell phones and smart watches that have communication abilities (e.g., apple watches can be used to text if they are attached to a phone number or wireless internet) to school. We want to ensure that students are engaged and focused at all times and these types of technology prevent their ability to do this. Administration will be confiscating this technology if it is seen at school, and parents will need to pick it up at the front office. Thank you for helping us ensure that our students succeed in school.

All students must use morning carpool for drop-off. No walk-ups.

Weekly COVID-19 Report—Updated

Cardinal Charter Academy strives to be completely transparent with our community while still protecting privacy. Each week, CCA will provide our families with an updated account of COVID-19 cases in the building along with a comparison to the week prior. Cardinal will continue to follow CDC and NCDHHS procedures and notify those who were **potentially exposed**. We are in consistent collaboration with the Wake County Health Department in an effort to prevent the spread of COVID within our community.

If there is a confirmed exposure or positive case in your home please keep your child(ren) at home and email Nurse Sophie Tyler styler@cardinalcharter.org immediately for further instructions related to quarantine and guidance moving forward.

As always, anyone who experiences symptoms associated with COVID-19 should contact their health care provider immediately and then advise Cardinal Charter Academy of any positive diagnosis for COVID-19.

COVID Information

As a reminder, the CDC recommends everyday preventive actions to limit the spread of respiratory viruses, including:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60 percent alcohol if soap and water are not available.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a cloth face cover when around others in public settings where social distancing is not feasible.
- Monitor your health daily, be alert for symptoms, and stay home when you are sick.

We have added to the safety protocols from last school year. For this school year we will be following the Strong Schools NC Public Health Toolkit (K-12) related to COVID-19 safety protocols and procedures. A link to the toolkit can be found here: <https://covid19.ncdhhs.gov/media/164/open>.

We are not requiring, but are strongly encouraging, everyone 12 and older who is eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccine to get one if they wish to do so. Masks are required for all students, staff, and volunteers in the building. Masks are worn except when eating/drinking or while outside.



COVID Protocols FAQs—*Updated*

1. How do I report a confirmed COVID case or confirmed exposure?

Email Nurse Sophie at styler@cardinalcharter.org to report any confirmed COVID cases in your family as well as any confirmed exposures.

2. What happens when a confirmed case is reported of an individual that has been present inside of the school building?

Once it is reported to Nurse Sophie, she immediately reports it to the Admin team. For a student that is confirmed positive, Nurse Sophie will contact the family and triage the situation. If the positive student has been inside of the building at all in the past 48 hours, any individuals considered to be close contacts (mask off and within 6 ft for over 15 minutes over a 24 hour period) will be notified. If it is a school day the identified close contacts will be isolated as discretely as possible and their parents will be notified immediately to come and pick them up to start their quarantine period.

3. How does the school determine who is a close contact?

We identify where your student eats lunch and snack, since that is the time of most vulnerability when their masks are off, and look at the teacher's seating chart to determine who sits within 6 ft of the individual who tested positive.

4. When can my child come back to school if they have tested positive?

If your child tests positive they can't return back to school until it has been 10 full days since their symptoms started or if no symptoms were present, 10 days from when the positive test result was received.

5. When can my child come back to school if they have been determined to be a close contact to someone who has tested positive for COVID?

If your child has been exposed to someone positive for COVID they will need to do a 7-day minimum quarantine and receive a negative COVID test result, taken no earlier than day 5 of their 7-day quarantine. If you do not want to have them tested, they will need to do a 10-day minimum quarantine and remain symptom free before they can return to school.

6. What if my child is showing symptoms of COVID (fever, cough, shortness of breath, fatigue, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, runny nose or congestion, chills, body aches, nausea, vomiting or diarrhea)?

Keep them, as well as any siblings, at home until you have the sick child tested for COVID. If the result is negative, then any siblings may return to school. The child who has symptoms, but tested negative must remain home until they have been fever free for over 24 hours and other symptoms are improving.

7. What if one of my children was exposed at school but they also have siblings that attend the school as well?

Only the exposed child will need to quarantine. Siblings to the exposed child will not be required to quarantine and can remain in school.

8. What if I have multiple children and only one of them tests positive?

The positive child will be required to complete a 10-day quarantine and can return to school after 10 days if they have been fever-free for 24 hours and other symptoms are improving as well. Unfortunately for the siblings in this situation, they are required to complete the original 10-day quarantine with their positive sibling. In addition to this they will be required to complete an additional 7-day minimum quarantine and be tested for COVID no earlier than day 5 of this 7-day quarantine. The reason they must do this is because their last date of exposure to the positive child is considered to be on day 10 of the positive child's quarantine period.

9. *What information is needed when reporting a confirmed case related to your student? *

Full name, grade, teacher, best contact number for parents, date of covid test, date results were received, location where the test was taken, what kind of test (antigen/rapid or PCR/molecular), date your child was last in school, if they have any symptoms and when the symptoms started, if they have had any know recent exposures, and vaccination status.

COVID Protocols FAQs Continued—*Updated*

10. *What if my family is traveling internationally or traveling out of state soon?*

We have been advised that for any travel, including both international OR domestic (out of the state of NC), a 7-day minimum quarantine is required starting the day after you return, with a covid test taken no earlier than day 5 of quarantine. As long as the results are negative, and they remain symptom free they are allowed to return to school after 7 full days have passed after you returned from your travels.

Cardinal is following the Strong Schools NC Toolkit for COVID policies and procedures related to quarantine found [here](#).

The Wake County Health Department has the FINAL say with the quarantines rules and we must follow what they ultimately advise once we report cases to them.

Special Resource Fair—New

The Eye Shine Foundation will be hosting a Very Special Resource Fair on Saturday, September 18 from 10:00 am – 2:00 pm. This is a FREE event for families to attend and meet with community partners who provide services for families with students with disabilities. Student Emergency Contact Cards

Please turn in the bright yellow Student Emergency Contact Cards to your child’s teacher ASAP. Cards were handed out at meet the teacher (MTT). If you did not attend MTT, they were sent home with your child last week to be filled out. Cardinal must have these on file for every student.

Absences

If students are home and sick, parents should email absences@cardinalcharter.org and their child’s home-room teacher to let the school know.

If a class is quarantined, parents don’t need to notify the school of their child’s absence. There is a special code in PowerSchool for quarantine. Administration will notify parents when their child may return to school.

If your child has traveled out of state and is, therefore, required to quarantine, email absences@cardinalcharter.org

If your family is home quarantined due to possible exposure to COVID-19 and your child isn’t sick, please still email absences@cardinalcharter.org and your child’s teacher.
